Egypt and the Holy Land

Walk where Jesus walked and experience the Peace of Christ in this Holy place

DAY, 01 Depart from home city to Cairo

DAY, 02 - CAIRO

Arrival in Cairo, where we will be met by our English speaking guide and transferred to your hotel for a welcome dinner and overnight. Remainder of day at leisure to relax after a long journey.

DAY, 03 - CAIRO

(BLD) We begin our day with a drive to Giza with our private Egyptologist / tour guide and visit to the Sphinx, Great Pyramid, and the Roval Burial Chambers. Continue to Memphis. to visit the recumbent statue of Ramses II and the 80-ton Alabaster Sphinx. Lunch en route. Continue to Sakara to see the prototype of the pyramids, the Step Pyramid, built for the 3rd Dynasty Pharaoh Djoser by the exalted architect Imhotep. Continuing south, visit the **Pyramid of Dahshour**. King Senefru,, father of King Cheops, built this pyramid, also known as the **Red Pyramid**, Return to Cairo to visit a **Papyrus Institute**. In Cairo we will be transferred to a boat on the Nile River where we will enjoy our Welcome Dinner Party. MASS or Service: St. Joseph's Church, in Zamalech

DAY 04 - CAIRO

Back to Cairo to visit the Ben Ezra Synagogue and continue to visit St. Mary Maadi Coptic Church where it is believed Moses was found. One of the strange phenomena is that they found a bible floating on the Nile (few years ago) open to the page that "blessed Egypt my people." Tonight, you will enjoy dinner in a typical Egyptian restaurant. MASS or Service: In a private room at the hotel

DAY 05 - Cairo - ST. CATHERINE

(BD) Drive to the Egyptian Museum of Antiguities for a private, detailed, guided tour. Among other fascinating exhibits, see the treasures of the tomb of Tutankhamen and walk around the mummies and examine them from all angles, gaze into their incredibly well preserved 3,000-year-old faces. Depart Cairo and drive to the Suez Canal. Take the tunnel under the Suez and arrive at the Sinai Peninsula. Enroute, visit Eyoun Moussa (Moses' Spring), Hamam Pharaoh, Church of Wadi Feiran. Drive to St. Catherine for dinner and overnight.

DAY 06 - EILAT

Wake up at 3:30AM and climb the Mountain of Moses. According to tradition, it was on this mountain that Moses received the Ten Commandments. It lies south of St. Catherine's Monastery and rises to a height of 7,497 feet. From the top, experience the spectacular sunrise as the dawn breaks over this land of penetrating beauty and mystery. This hike is only for people who are very fit and experienced in hiking. Descend for breakfast at the hotel. Visit the Monastery of St. Catherine, which sits at an altitude of 5,150 feet on the reputed site of the "Burning Bush." Commissioned by Emperor Justinian, the monastery was built between the years 527 and 565. Depart St. Catherine for Taba, on the border with Israel. Cross into Israel and continue to your hotel in Eilat, on the Red Sea. Remainder of the day at leisure to shop and explore. Dinner at hotel. MASS or Service: In a private room at the hotel.

DAY 07 - TIBERIAS

Depart Eilat towards Timna Valley and climb on King Solomon's Pillars. Continue to Massada. Take the cable car to the top of the rock and visit the Roman palaces, storehouses, synagogues and bathhouse, which witnessed the Jewish resistance to the Romans approximately 2,000 years ago. Driving along the Dead Sea and the Jordan Valley, we arrive in Tiberias for Mass or Service, dinner/overnight.

DAY 08 - TIBERIAS

Take a private boat ride across the Sea of Galilee and arrive in Kibbutz Genosar and visit the fisherman's boat found in 1986, dated back to the days of Jesus. Continue to Capernaum to visit Peter's House. Later, visit Tabga, the Church of the Multiplication on the Mt. of Beatitudes, where the Sermon on the Mount took place. Drive along the West Bank of the Sea of Galilee to the Jordan River where John baptized Jesus. Return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight. MASS or Service: Mount of the Beatitudes

DAY 09 - JERUSALEM

Drive to Nazareth and visit the Church of the Annunciation and St. Joseph's Grotto. Drive to Megiddo to see the site of the Armageddon, King Solomon's Stables. Drive to the ruins of the ancient Roman city of Caesarea. Visit the Roman Theater and the Aqueduct. Then climb the Judean Hills to the most beautiful city in the world, Jerusalem, for dinner and overnight. Mass or Service: Nazareth, Church of Annunciation.

DAY 10 - JERUSALEM

Drive to the Mount of Olives and Garden of Gethsemane. Enter the Old City, to the Pool of Bethesda. Walk the Via **Dolorosa** to the Holy Sepulcher Church. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight. Mass or Service: Mt of Olives, Dominus Flevit.

DAY 11 - JERUSALEM

Visit Caiphas' House, Mt. Zion, David's Tomb and the Last Supper Room. Enter the Old City through the Zion Gate and start a walking tour of the Old City. Walk down the stairs to the Western Wall. Visit the "Temple Steps", with the original steps that led to the entrance of the Temple 2000 years ago & the Wall Excavations, also known as the Rabbinical Tunnels, Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight. Mass or Service: Church of Peter in Galicantus.
