## Day 01 Depart home city for ROME.

#### Day 02 Rome - Assisi (D)

Arrival in **Rome**, **Italy**. We will be met by our tour director and transferred by motor coach through the lush Umbrian countryside to **Assisi**, hometown of our beloved **St**.

Francis. Remainder of the day at leisure to wander the medieval, winding streets of this

Day 03 Assisi (BD)

We begin our day with a visit to the **Basilica of St. Francis** with frescos by Giotto and the tomb of St. Francis. Visit the **Church of St. Clare** housing her incorrupt body and the **Cross of San Damiano.** Continue to lower **Assis**i visiting the **Portiuncula**, the little church that St. Francis built, housed inside the **Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli**. #### Day 04 Assisi - Florence

Morning departure through the *rolling hills of Tuscany* as we make our way to **Florence**, rich with Renaissance art treasures of Da Vinci and Botticelli including a visit to the *Academy of Fine Art* to view Michelangelo's magnificent "David." Afternoon visit of the great *Duomo* - Santa Maria del Fiori, *Baptistery* and bronze "Doors of Paradise." Remainder of day to wander through Renaissance Florence "as you please."

Day 05 Florence (BD)

Today visit to the Franciscan Church of Santa Croce, *final resting place of Michelangelo, Galileo, and Machiavelli*. Remainder of day to discover Florence "as you please." Art lovers might enjoy a visit to the **Ufizzi Gallery**, greatest collection of Renaissance art. The piazza of **Santa Croce** is known for it's magnificent **Florentine gold and leather goods**. Tonight enjoy dinner in a festive local Florentine restaurant.

#### Day 06 Florence - Siena - Medjugorje

Morning departure from Florence through Tuscany dotted with Chianti vineyards & olive groves to old **Siena**, the best preserved medieval town in Italy. Visit the Cathedral and St. Domenic's Church which houses the incorrupt **St. Catherine of Siena**, doctor of the Church. We will also visit the famous shell shaped **Piazza del Campo**, where the famous **Palio** (annual 75 second horse race) is held every summer. Late afternoon transfer to **Rome airport** for our flight to Split. We will be met and transferred 2 hours by motor coach to **Medjugorje**, peaceful village in Bosnia where **Our Lady continues to appear daily** to the visionaries since June 24, 1981. Enjoy our 3 night stay where we will be graciously housed with Ante and Alenka, **Vicka's family home**. The visionaries in Medjugorje tell us that no one goes to Medjugorje by accident. Day 07 Medjugorje (BD)
